# CAMDEN STATE PARK

Camden State Park offers much for visitors to enjoy. Fish for brown trout in the Redwood River or bass and bluegill in Browner Lake. Hike the trails or cool off in the spring-fed pool. Walk along the wooded river valley, climb the Dakota Valley Trail to the lookout for great fall colors, or go canoeing on Browner Lake. Woodlands, maples, basswoods, oaks, and cottonwoods dominate this park. Sun-drenched prairies, grasslands and marshes offer added diversity. The park provides picnic areas, campgrounds, lawn-in, horseback and group swimming, hiking and cross-country skiing.
